3 08-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 365/34 of the Indian Penal
Code.

The father of the informant had gone along with
Nanki Chaudhary. Thereafter, there is suspicion against
different persons, including the petitioner for different reasons
for commission of murder of the father of the informant.

Considering the nature of allegation and nature of
material in the case diary against the petitioner, let the
petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail
bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two
sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned



court below where the case is pending in connection with Lauriya Police Station Case No.277 of 2018, subject to condition that both the bailors shall be resident of within the territorial jurisdiction of the learned court below and the petitioner shall fully co-operate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
