Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Chanpatia P.S. Case No. 378 of 2018 for the offence under Section 363 and 366-A of the Indian Penal Code.

In view of the statement of the victim recorded under Section 164 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, which has been brought on record by way of Annexure-2 to this application, this application is allowed.

Let the petitioners above named, in the event of



their arrest/surrender within six weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M.-V, Bettiah, West Champaran, in Chanpatia P.S. Case No. 378 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

This is subject to the condition that the petitioners shall present themselves before the Police/Court, as the case may be, as and when required and in the event of failure on their part to appear before the Court on two consecutive occasions, their bail bonds shall be liable to be cancelled.
