ORAL ORDER

2 19-02-2019 Petitioner seeks bail in anticipation of his arrest in connection with Rupaspur P.S. Case No. 443 of 2018 registered for the offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Allegation is of recovery of 62 litres of liquor from the car of the petitioner, which was found in abandoned condition.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that Annexure-2 clearly shows that the car was transferred in the name of the petitioner with effect from 25.10.2018, whereas seizure was made on 14.10.2018.

Heard learned APP also.

Having heard both sides and in the facts and



circumstances, let petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of six weeks from the receipt of this order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Special Judge, Excise Act, Patna, in connection with Special Case No. 10040 of 2018, arising out of Rupaspur P.S. Case No. 443 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure and further condition that one of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immoveable properties within the jurisdiction of the court concerned.
