2 25-02-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with
Shikarpur P.S. Case No. 412/2018, for the offence under Section
414/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner has no criminal antecedent. In the instant case the
police on suspicion arrested Sahjad Ansari with motorcycle and
when the police asked him to produce the document of
ownership of the motorcycle he did not produce. The police
suspected the motorcycle to be stolen one. The co-accused
Sahjad Ansari later on disclosed the name of this petitioner.

The petitioner is in custody since 06.11.2018.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has no criminal
antecedent and he has remained in custody for more than three



months, the petitioner named above, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000 (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, West Champaran, Bettiah in connection with Shikarpur P.S. Case No. 412/2018.
