2 07-03-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

In the present writ application, the petitioner has prayed for a direction to the respondent-authorities to issue Arms License to the petitioner.

The petitioner apprehends danger of his life and property and, as such, he had applied for Arms Licence vide Annexure-1 to the writ application with affidavit dated 31-07-2018. The said application is pending till date whereas as per rule 13 of the Arms Rule, 2016, the said application ought to have been disposed of within a period of 60 days from the date of receipt/production of the police report.



Considering the relief sought for in the present writ application, the District Magistrate, Bettiah, West Champaran (respondent No. 3) is directed to consider the application of the petitioner and pass an appropriate order in accordance with law at the earliest.

With the aforesaid observation/direction, this writ application stands disposed of.
