learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offence punishable under Section 302/34 of the Indian Penal
Code.

There is allegation against the petitioner and other FIR
named accused persons that they having entered into the house
of the deceased cut his neck as a result of which he died. The
postmortem report goes to show that only one injury was found
on the neck of the deceased. Moreover, having more or less
similar allegation, co-accused Brij Kishore Rai, Jai Narayan
Rai, Jang Bahadur Rai, Ranjeet Rai and Rajesh Rai have already
been granted privilege of bail by different Benches of this Court.



Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as well as submissions of the parties, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-IV, East Champaran at Motihari in connection with Madhuban P.S. Case No. 43 of 2018.
