Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court deems it fit and proper to direct the District Magistrate, Saharsa to consider the case of the petitioner for appointment on compassionate ground, if appropriate application has been made in the prescribed format, and pass a reasoned order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.
