2 19-02-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and

learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 418, 419 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

Maternal grandfather of the complainant had executed a registered deed of gift in favour of the petitioners in the year 1994. The maternal grandfather died in the year 2010. Thereafter, the complainant raised the issue that the deed of gift is a forged. A civil suit is also going on between the parties.

Considering the entire facts aforesaid, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or



surrender before the Court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.20,000/- (rupees twenty thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Complaint Case No. C1-351 of 2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as condition that the petitioners shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioners.
