**2      04-04-2019**                      Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the respondent-State.

Petitioner's claim in the writ petition is for consideration for appointment, by way of regularization, in the Collectorate of West Champaran at Bettiah.

The respondents have, by the impugned order, held that the petitioner's claim will be considered as per seniority arising out of the panel which was prepared in the year, 2011. Since, none, below the petitioner, has been given the benefit of



regularization, ignoring his claim, the petitioner cannot have any grievance.

In view of the stand of the State, however, that the claim of the petitioner would be considered as per seniority in accordance with law, no further direction is required to be issued in the instant writ petition. The same is disposed of.

Respondents would be obliged to stand by their commitment, as given in the counter affidavit.
