3 02-09-2019 In pursuance to the earlier order of this Court dated
22.07.2019, the respondent Nagar Parishad, Madhubani has
filed a counter affidavit wherein it has been stated that all the
admitted outstanding retiral dues of the petitioner has been
paid, details whereof has been mentioned in paragraph nos. 6
and 7 of the said counter affidavit.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that if
