2 26-02-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with Gandhi
Maidan P.S. Case No. 597 of 2018 for the offences under
Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 472, 473, 120(B)/34 of the
Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since
23.11.2018. He further submits that petitioner has been made
accused in the instant case only on suspicion that different bank
accounts are in the name of different persons but in the Adhar
Card of the petitioner.



Considering the fact that petitioner has no criminal antecedent, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, let the petitioner named above be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-17th, Patna in connection with Gandhi Maidan P.S. Case No. 597 of 2018.
