as the learned counsel for the petitioner was desirous for  
consideration of his case during vacation.

The slip for listing was filed pursuant to notice dated  
08th May 2019, published prior to the vacation.

both parties are present and willing to assist the Court for  
disposal of the matter.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the  
respondent-State.



For grant of revised Grade Pay of Rs 4,200, on account of first Assured Career Progression (for brevity, ACP), the claim of the petitioner is pending before the District Magistrate, East Champaran, Motihari. However, the same has not been disposed of till date.

Mr Jitendra Kumar Roy appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be submitting a fresh representation before the District Magistrate, East Champaran, Motihari (respondent No 2) as during pendency of the writ proceedings, the petitioner has realized that his claim for benefit under second ACP is also to be considered by the respondent-authorities.

Since the representation is to be made before respondent No 2, consideration also has to be done by the said Authority.

In the circumstance, this writ petition need not be kept pending.

In the event, petitioner submits his representation within four weeks from today, the District Magistrate, East Champaran, Motihari (respondent No 2) would be obliged to consider the same and dispose it of by reasoned and speaking order in accordance with law within a period of eight weeks



thereafter.

Dues, found admissible, should also be paid to the  
petitioner within a period of one month thereafter.

Writ petition stands disposed of.
