3 12-04-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under
Sections 397, 412 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25(1-
B)a/26/35 of the Arms Act.

Allegation is that arms and motorcycle are alleged to
have been recovered.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
the petitioner is in custody since 28.10.2018 and has got no
criminal antecedent. Charge sheet has been submitted in the
case. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged
against the petitioner. Arms is said to have been recovered from
the co-accused Sunny Kuer. So far the petitioner is concerned,
stolen motorcycle is said to have been recovered from the



orchard/dalan belonging to the joint family of the petitioner.
Petitioner has remained in custody for about six months. There
is no compliance of Section 100 of Cr.P.C.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the
petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let
the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing
bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of
the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M. II,
Patna City in connection with Sahjahanpur P.S. case No.82 of
2018.
