So far other relief is concerned, the petitioner may file exhaustive representation addressed to the District Programme Officer (Establishment), Aurangabad who shall address the grievance of the petitioner by reason and speaking order within the time of sixty days.

With the aforesaid, the writ application stands disposed of.
