2 08-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody for the
offence punishable under Section 379 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner is in custody since 08.06.2018. The
FIR of the occurrence of commission of theft is against
unknown. Confessional statement of the petitioner is there
before the police after arrest by the police. Nothing has been
recovered from the possession of the petitioner nor the
petitioner was put on Test Identification Parade.

Considering the period already undergone and
completion of investigation, let the petitioner, above named, be
released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty



Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court-below where the case is pending in connection with Barauni Rail P.S. Case No.48 of 2018, with following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned Court-below having immovable property in his name.

(b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
