3 07-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 147,148,149,324,307 of the
Indian Penal Code and 27 of the Arms Act.

The petitioner allegedly caused firearm injury
at the right leg of the son of the informant near the knee. Old
enmity is reason for the commission of the occurrence as well as
claim for false implication. The Doctor has found firearm injury
consistent with the prosecution allegation. Petitioner is in
custody since 07.01.2019.

Considering the entire facts, let the petitioner,
above named, be released on bail **after completion of nine**
months of custody if the trial is not concluded in spite of full



cooperation of the petitioner on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Ariari (Kesar) Police Station Case No.152 of 2018, subject to the condition that both bailors shall be resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned court below and further the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
