ORAL ORDER

2 08-03-2019 The petitioners seek bail in anticipation of their arrest in connection with Tarapur P.S. Case No. 164 of 2018, dated 20.10.2018, instituted for the offences under Sections 366A/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 8 of the Prevention of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012.

After some arguments, Mr. Manohar Prasad Singh, the learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw this petition in order to enable the petitioners to



surrender before the Court below and seek regular bail.

The petition is, accordingly, dismissed as withdrawn.

In case, such a petition is filed before the Court below within a period of six weeks from today, the Court below shall take into account that the main accused of this case has already been granted bail and, thereafter, shall pass order in accordance with the law on its own merits, without being at all prejudiced by the fact that the present anticipatory bail application has not been entertained by this Court.
