2. The petitioner has moved the Court under Section
482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for the following
relief:

*“That this is an application for
quashing the order dated 17.11.2014 passed by
the learned Principal Judge, Family Court,
Saran at Chapra in Divorce Case No. 6 of
2013 whereby an application filed under
Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act by
Opposite party No. 2 was allowed and
petitioner was directed to pay a sum of Rs.
3000/- per month as ad-interim maintenance
to the O.P. No. 2 besides a sum of Rs. 5000/-
as expenses of the proceeding.”*

3. After some arguments, as prayed for by learned



counsel for the petitioner, the application stands disposed off as
withdrawn.
