2 25-02-2019 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with Piprasi P.S. Case No. 70 of 2018 registered for the offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition Excise Act, 2016.

The allegation is regarding recovery of 13 litres of illicit liquor from the petitioner.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is submitted that though the petitioner is an accused in two other case but he is on bail in the said two cases. Lastly, it is submitted that the petitioner is languishing in custody since 03.01.2019.



Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise, West Champaran, Bettiah in connection with Piprasi P.S. Case No. 70 of 2018.
