learned counsel appearing for the State.

This appeal is directed against the order dated
05.01.2019 passed by 1st Additional Sessions Judge-cum-
Special Judge, Katihar in A.B.P. No. 116 of 2018 in connection
with SC/ST P.S. Case No. 149 of 2018 registered under
sections 323, 354B of the Indian Penal Code and Sections
3(i)(r), 3(2)(va) of the S.C. and S.T. (Prevention of Atrocities)
Act.

Learned counsel appearing for the appellant
submits that the appellant has been falsely implicated in this
case due to previous enmity. The present complaint case has
been filed after 20 days of the alleged occurrence without



there being any explanation for the delay. Appellant has no criminal antecedent.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the appellant, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 25,000/- (Twentyfive thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of 1st Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Katihar in connection with SC/ST P.S. Case No. 49 of 2018 subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

This appeal is allowed and the impugned order is set aside.
