3 30-04-2019 This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail in

connection with Mohania P.S. Case No. 10 of 2018, disclosing

offences under Sections 379/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation as per F.I.R. is that truck of the petitioner
was seized and kept in the police custody and the petitioner and
other accused persons has taken away the truck from the police
custody.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is
that the truck was seized in connection with Mohania P.S. Case
No. 703 of 2017 and no seizure list was prepared and the
vehicle was handed over to the petitioner and now this false
case has been lodged against the petitioner.

Heard learned A.P.P. also, who opposed the prayer for
anticipatory bail of the petitioner.



Having heard both sides, in view of the facts and circumstances of the case as stated above, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, rather he should surrender and make prayer for regular bail, which will be considered on the basis of materials available on record.

Accordingly, this application is dismissed.
