3 06-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody for the offence punishable under Section 304B/34 of the Indian Penal Code in connection with Daraunda P.S. Case No. 222 of 2017.

Petitioner is husband of the victim of dowry death. Wife of the petitioner died within a year of her marriage in her matrimonial house in unnatural circumstance.

Allegation is of demand of Rs. 25,000/- and a gold chain and for non-fulfillment of the same torture to the victim. Other witnesses have also supported the allegation of demand and torture.

Submission is that there is no eye-witness of the occurrence nor any complain of dowry demand was ever made



before the death of the victim.

Considering the entire facts and presumption of commission of dowry death, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Hence, his prayer for bail is refused.

Learned trial Court is directed to expedite the trial.
