2 01-03-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with
Neemchak Bathani P.S. Case No. 133 of 2018 (corresponding
G.R. No. 6968 of 2018) for the offences under Sections 452/34
of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25(1-B)A, 26 and 35 of
the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since
15.10.2018. He further submits that the allegation against this
petitioner is that on search one country made pistol and two live
cartridges was recovered from his possession.

Considering the fact that petitioner has remained in
custody for more than four and half months, the Court is



inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, let the petitioner named above be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-X, Gaya in connection with Neemchak Bathani P.S. Case No. 133 of 2018 (corresponding G.R. No. 6968 of 2018).
