2 26-02-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with Jhajha
P.S. Case No. 167 of 2014 for the offence under Sections
147/148/149/353/307 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27
of the Arms Act and Section 16, 20 of the UAP Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submit that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this
case. He further submits that in the instant case petitioner has
remained in jail prison since 11.5.2018. Learned counsel for the
petitioner further submits that the name of the petitioner
surfaced in the instant case by the police spy.

Considering the fact that the name of the petitioner
surfaced in the instant case by the police spy and he has



remained in custody for more than 09 months, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Court of learned Sessions Judge, 1st Jamui, in connection with Jhajha P.S. Case No. 167 of 2014, subject to the conditions that his both bailors should be local farmers having more than five acres of land in the locality.
