learned counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in connection with Deo P.S. Case No.149 of 2018, registered for the offence punishable under Sections 498(A)/34 of the Indian Penal Code and 3/4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961.

The petitioners are in-laws of the victim lady. The specific allegation has been made against her husband, who is in jail custody.

Looking to the entire facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioners, above-named, be released on



anticipatory bail in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Aurangabad, in connection with Deo P.S. Case no.149 of 2018, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
