Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 272, 273, 308/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 30(a), 38(a) and 41(i) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

The recovery of liquor is not alleged from possession of the petitioner or from the house of the petitioner. Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent.

Hence, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (rupees twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to



the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending in connection with Nautan Police Station Case No. 181 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as condition that the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
