The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Nawada P.S. Case No. 950 of 2018 for the offences punishable
under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act,
2016.

The allegation is regarding recovery of 50 liters of
Mahua liquor from the house of the petitioner.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is
further submitted that the petitioner is having a clean antecedent
and is languishing in custody since 24.12.2018.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the



case, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be enlarged on regular bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge- cum- Additional District & Sessions Judge-II, Nawada in connection with Nawada P.S.
