The petitioner prays for provisional release of Truck  
bearing registration No. UP-82T 3041, which has been seized  
in connection with Mashrak P.S. Case No.267 of 2018 for  
alleged violation of provisions of Bihar Prohibition and Excise  
Act, 2016 but taking note of nature of the seizure which



reflects recovery of 6000 litres of country made liquor, we are not persuaded to grant indulgence in this writ petition. Accordingly, this writ petition is dismissed.

The petitioner would be at liberty to contest the seizure in the statutory proceeding under the Statute.
