APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in **Saraiya P.S. Case No.413 of 2018** instituted for the offence under Section(s) 302, 201/34 Indian Penal Code.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is a lady. She is not named in the First Information Report. Name of the petitioner has come in this case merely on suspicion. She is in custody since 15.09.2018 having clean antecedents. Husband of the deceased is already in custody.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail is allowed. Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount



each to the satisfaction of the **Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, 1st, West, Muzaffarpur**, in connection with **Saraiya P.S. Case No.413 of 2018**, subject to the condition that both the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioner.
