The petitioners have challenged the order dated
02.01.2013 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist
Class, Hilsa, Nalanda in Complaint Case No. 500C of 2012,
whereby cognizance has been taken under Sections 341,
323 and 354/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

No good ground has been made out for this Court
to interfere with the order of cognizance. However, the



petitioners would be at liberty to avail of the remedies which are available to them under law.
