ORAL ORDER

2 15-05-2019 Having regard to the fact that the order taking cognizance is dated 7.12.2013, the Court is not inclined to exercise jurisdiction under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

However, liberty shall be available to the petitioners to file a petition for discharge at appropriate stage and on filing of such discharge petition, the court below shall address each and every issue raised by the petitioners in the discharge petition and pass reasoned and speaking order meeting all the issues raised by the petitioners in the discharge petition. On filing of



the discharge petition, appropriate order shall be passed by the court below within a maximum period of 60 days from the date of filing of such petition.

With the aforesaid, the application stands disposed of.
