jurisdiction, the Court is not inclined to proceed any further in

and (2014) 3 SCC 373. However, liberty shall be available to
the petitioner to challenge the legality and validity of the
decision taken by the opposite party vide Annexure-A to the
show cause and also raise the issue as to non-removal of the
encroachment in appropriate proceeding in accordance with law.

stands disposed of.
