2 02-04-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory
bail in connection with Special Case No.11369 of 2018, arising
out of Budha Colony P.S. (P.R.) Case No. 82 of 2018, registered
for the offence under Sections 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and
Excise Act, 2016.

2.250 liters of illegal liquor has been recovered
from a plastic bag.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Looking to the quantum of liquor recovered from
the plastic bag, let the above-named petitioner, be released on



anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Special Judge, Excise, Patna, in connection with Special Case No.11369 of 2018, arising out of Budha Colony P.S. Case (P.R.) No.82 of 2018, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

However, at the time of accepting bail bonds, the court below would verify and assure itself regarding the criminal antecedent of the petitioner. If he is having clean antecedent, then his bail bonds would be accepted. If he is found to be involved in any other case before filing of this application i.e. 30.03.2019 then his bail bonds would be accepted.
