ORAL ORDER

2 06-03-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioners are in custody in connection with Special Case No. 01 of 2019, arising out of Amarpur P.S. Case No. 8 of 2019 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 20, 22, 25 of N.D.P.S. Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have no criminal antecedent. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that in the instant case total 102 gm Ganja was recovered. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that petitioners are in custody since 06.1.2019.

Considering the fact that the petitioners have no



criminal antecedent and recovery of little quantity of Ganja, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners, let the petitioners named above be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Learned District & Sessions Judge, Banka, in connection with Special Case No. 01 of 2019 (Arising out of Amarpur P.S. Case No. 08 of 2019).
