ORAL ORDER

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Jalalpur P.S. Case No. 192 of 2018, registered under Sections 302, 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code, pending in the court of the A.C.J.M-IX, Saran at Chapra.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the



petitioner submits that, admittedly, the marriage of the petitioner was performed with the deceased in the year 2006, but she committed suicide by hanging. Further submission is that, in fact, deceased used to left the house for some days and when villagers started questioning about her absence then she committed suicide and she wrote a suicidal note stating that no person of her matrimonial house is responsible for her suicide.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case and the nature of allegation against the petitioner, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, his prayer for grant of anticipatory bail stands rejected. The petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court within four weeks and pray for regular bail, which would be considered by the trial Court in accordance with law without being prejudiced by the order of this Court.
