Petitioners are employees of district civil court,

benefit of ACP with effect from due date in terms of Annexure 2
i.e. Resolution of the Screening committee dated 10.06.2011.

Claim of petitioners has been made by Annexure 3
dated 31.01.2013. However, same has not been disposed off till

date.
