2 06-03-2019 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the
learned APP for the State.

The petitioners seek regular bail in connection with
Excise Case No. C1-421/2018 for the offences punishable under
Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

The allegation is regarding recovery of 144.06 liters
of illicit liquor from a tempo, of which the petitioner no.1 is
said to be the driver and the petitioner no.2 is said to be a
passenger.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that
the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present case.
It is further submitted that the petitioners are having a clean



antecedent and are languishing in custody since 31.12.2018.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioners, above named, are directed to be enlarged on regular bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge and cum Spl. Judge (Excise) Patna in connection with Excise Case No. C1-421 of 2018.
