learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Excise Case No. 730 of 2018 registered for the offence
punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Excise Prohibition
Act, 2016.

The allegation is regarding recovery of 17 litres of
spirit from a place where the petitioner is stated to be standing.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. It
is further submitted that the petitioner is having a clean
antecedent and he is languishing in custody since 19.12.2018.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the



case, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-7th-cum-Special Judge, Excise, East Champaran, Motihari in connection with Excise Case No. 730 of 2018.
