upon the respondents to consider his claim of compassionate

appointment pursuant to recommendation made by the District

Compassionate Selection Committee, Patna under Memo no.

Respondents have filed their counter affidavit. Stand

has been taken that the father of the petitioner died on
4.12.2009. As per the extant provision, the ward of deceased

been offered appointment. Since no further vacancies are vacant

claim of the petitioner who was lower in priority could not be



considered till filing of the counter affidavit in 2015.

Counsel for the State submits that what has happened thereafter is not on record. It is not clear whether sufficient number of vacancies are available for petitioner's appointment or not.

Be that as it may, since none appears on behalf of the petitioner, writ petition is dismissed for non prosecution.
