ORAL ORDER

2 06-03-2019 The petitioner has put to challenge an order dated 07.07.2018, passed by the Arbitrator-cum-Additional Collector, Aurangabad in L.A. Case No. 337/2016-17, whereby the petitioner's claim for more compensation has been rejected. The award of the Arbitrator, in my view, can be questioned under Section 34 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 before the Court of original civil jurisdiction.

This application is disposed of with the liberty to the petitioner to invoke the said provision under the Arbitration and



Conciliation Act, 1996 to question the correctness of the award.
If the petitioner makes such application and any question of
limitation arises, the Court may consider this aspect that the
petitioner was pursuing his remedy before this Court by filing
the present writ application.
