2 15-03-2019 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner
and the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in anticipation of her arrest in connection with Chapra Muffasil P.S. Case No. 237 of 2018 dated 11.06.2018 instituted for the offences under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 324, 307, 379 and 500 of the Indian Penal Code.

Two persons are said to have been injured in the occurrence in which the petitioner is also said to have participated. The injuries suffered by the victims have been opined to be simple in nature. The petitioner is only alleged to have divested one of the members of the side of the prosecution of her nose-stud. The petitioner and the informant are next door neighbours and there is a pending land dispute between them.



Considering the aforestated facts viz. the accusation and the gender of the petitioner, she is directed to be released on bail, in the event of her arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, on her furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Saran at Chapra in connection with Chapra Muffasil P.S. Case No. 237 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
