6 31-07-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
State.

The petitioner seeks bail in **Sessions Trial No. 09**
of 2019 arising out of Katoriya (Suiya) P.S. Case No. 291 of
2015, instituted for the offence under Section(s) 302/34 of
Indian Penal Code.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is
in custody since 17.12.2018 having clean antecedent. He is not
named in the written report. The name of petitioner has been
disclosed by co-accused Teklal Yadav in his confessional
statement who has already been acquitted by the court below
vide Judgment dated 17.11.2017.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances
of the case, prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail is allowed.



Let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned **Additional Sessions Judge-III, Banka**, in connection with **Sessions Trial No. 09 of 2019 arising out of Katoriya (Suiya) P.S. Case No. 291 of 2015**, subject to the condition that both the bailors will be close relatives of the petitioner.
