learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with Forbesganj P.S. Case No. 53 of 2018, corresponding to S.T. No. 125 of 2018 for the offenses under Sections 413, 414/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the name of the petitioner surfaced on the confessional statement of co-accused Ashok Kumar Yadav. The petitioner has been remanded in this case on 18.4.2018. He has remained in custody for more than 10 months.

Considering the period of custody in a case under Sections 413, 414/34, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Let the petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail



on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the 3rd Additional Sessions Judge, Araria in connection with Forbesganj P.S. Case No. 53 of 2018, corresponding to S.T. No. 125 of 2018.
