2 07-03-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with
Belaganj P.S. Case No. 21 of 2019 for the offences under
Sections 379 and 411 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since
12.01.2019. He further submits that in the instant case petitioner
has been made accused in connection with seizure of 50 Iron
Centering Plate in Belaganj P.S. Case No. 21 of 2019 registered
on 11.01.2019 and out of 50 Iron plates 48 piece plate was
recovered from the house of Md. Zahir and one tempo was
recovered from the house of Binu Sharma but nothing was



recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner.

Considering the fact that petitioner has no criminal antecedent, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, let the petitioner named above be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-XI, Gaya in connection with Belaganj P.S. Case No. 21 of 2019.
