2 14-03-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 414,
379/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Co-accused, *Deepak Kumar @ Dipak Kumar*
Mahto was apprehended by the Police, while he was carrying
stolen transmission wire of electricity company on a pick-up
van. He disclosed the name of the petitioner and others as co-
culprits, who fled away from there. Petitioner has got no
criminal antecedent.

Considering the fact that there is no sufficient
material to compel the petitioner to go to jail, let the petitioner,
above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the



court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below where the case is pending in connection with Nayagaown Police Station Case No.85 of 2018, subject to conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as condition that the petitioner shall fully co-operate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
