4 03-05-2019 This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail in connection with Bhagwanpur Hat P.S. Case No. 142 of 2018, disclosing offences under Sections 147, 341, 323, 379, 384 and 427 of the Indian Penal code.

Allegation against the petitioner is that he along with other accused persons stopped the bus and assaulted the driver and snatched the booking amount of Rs. 42,000/-.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that he is aged about 69 years and whole allegation appears to be false and concocted and considering the same, other co-accused person has been granted privilege of anticipatory bail vide order dated 14.03.2019 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 16024 of 2019.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.



Having heard both sides, in view of the facts and circumstances as stated above, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM, 2nd, Siwan in connection with Bhagwanpur Hat P.S. Case No. 142 of 2018, subject to that condition that laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
