ORAL ORDER

2 08-03-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending her arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 304B and 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

This is a case under Section 304B/34 of the Indian Penal Code. The husband of the victim faced trial which resulted in acquittal for the reason that all the prosecution witnesses including informant of the case did not support the prosecution case.

In the circumstance, let the petitioner, above named, who is *gotni* of the deceased, in the event of her arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (rupees twenty



thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending in connection with Sarairanjan (Ghatho) Police Station Case No. 82 of 2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as condition that the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
