APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in **Jalalpur P.S. Case No.142 of
2018** instituted for the offence under Section(s) 366-A/34 Indian
Penal Code.

It is alleged that daughter of the informant went to
school on the date of occurrence, but she did not return.

From the impugned order, it appears that informant
has appeared in Court and stated that his daughter has gone with
one Nakul Sah with her own sweet will and he has
compromised the case with the petitioner. Aforesaid
compromise petition has been enclosed as Annexure-2 to the
bail application. Petitioner is father of Nakul Sah.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of



the petitioner for grant of bail is allowed. Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the **Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, 9, Saran, Chapra**, in connection with **Jalalpur P.S. Case No.142 of 2018**, subject to the condition that both the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioner.
