Counsel for the petitioner submits that in spite of having obtained 12 marks in the process of selection for constable in backward class category, his candidature has not been considered.

The respondents have filed counter affidavit. It is their specific stand that the final selection in the petitioner's category of BC (2) was of candidates having 13 marks. The petitioner was admittedly having 12 marks. In the circumstance his marks was less than the last cut of marks for the purpose of final selection. The vacancies have also been exhausted in the process of selection. Since none below to the petitioner has been



selected, petitioner cannot be allowed to contend any discrimination. The averments made in the counter affidavit have not been denied or disputed by filing any rejoinder or reply.

Writ petition is devoid of merit and the same is dismissed.
