ORAL ORDER

2 27-03-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with Sangrampur P.S. Case No. 212 of 2018 for the offence under Sections 272, 273 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 30(a) and 41(i) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since 13.12.2018. He further submits that in the instant case 3456 litres of foreign liquor was seized from a truck. He further submits that the petitioner is neither the owner of the truck nor the owner of the liquor and he is only a cleaner.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and he has remained in custody for more



than three months, the petitioner, named above, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Sessions Judge-VII-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, East Champaran, Motihari in connection with Sangrampur P.S. Case No. 212 of 2018.
